TIME TO SAVE PROGRAMME - 5-MIN SHOWER CHALLENGE

PUB has launched the above programme to educate students on how to have a quick shower and save water. All P3 and P4 students are invited to participate in this programme. The students have been given an activity book and a waterproof timer.

Students are required to time their shower for 7 days and record the timing in the activity book on page 9. At the end of the 7 days, they are to tear out pages 8-9 and submit it to their Form Teacher. The students can keep the timers. Visuals on how to operate the timer and record the shower timings can be found below this letter.

Data from this programme will be used by PUB to study the showering patterns and trends of Singaporean and in their effort to educate the public on water conservation. The students will be given until 6 April for their submission. Family members can also participate in the programme.

I hope parents can use this opportunity to educate their children on using water wisely. Your child would have also received some stickers on water saving tips, which they can display in the house to remind everyone to conserve water.

TIME TO SAVE PROGRAMME

KEEP IT TO 5!

STEP 1

- When getting ready to shower, place the timer in the shower room (you can place it on the tiled wall as it has a suction cup).
- Press the start button when starting to shower.




START/STOP BUTTON

STEP 2

- Once timer reaches 5 mins it will beep. That is to alert you that 5 minutes is up.
- If you are not done with showering, don't worry just carry on showering but bear in mind that 5 minutes has lapsed.
- The timer will go on after the beep .
- Once you are done, quickly stop the timer to see your shower timing .

STEP 3

- Note your shower timing down on page 9 of the activity booklet for 7 consecutive days.
- Same goes for your family member.



For each reduced minute, you can save 9 litres of water. Keep your shower under 5 minutes and track your shower duration for the next 7 days using the table below.



STEP 3
