
1) CCE Lessons



POSITIVE DISCIPLINE (by Jane Nelsen)

- Mutual Respect
- Identifying the belief behind the behaviour
- Effective communication and problem solving skills
- Discipline that teaches Neither Permissive nor Punitive
- Focusing on solutions instead of punishment
- Encouragement instead of praise

All P1 Students are dismissed from <u>Gate 3</u> (near Blk 508).






SAFETY & SECURITY – School Dismissal


